VILLAGE UPDATE

Please note the changes to the Village bus timetable to St Ives. The Tuesday bus leaves at 11am and there is an additional bus on Wednesday at 1pm.

As advised by NSW Health, from **Monday 11th October** those fully vaccinated can have up to 5 visitors in their home, 1 person per 4 sqm allowed inside and 1 person per 2 sqm outside. Retail stores can open with 1 person per 4 sqm. Hairdressers can open with 1 person per 4 sqm.

Our Hairdresser Karen will soon advise when she will be returning to the salon. She will be able to take one fully vaccinated resident at a time. You must wear a mask, sign in using the QR code at reception and wait in the Lounge until called.

Please continue to wear your mask, practice good hand hygiene and social distance 1.5 metres apart.

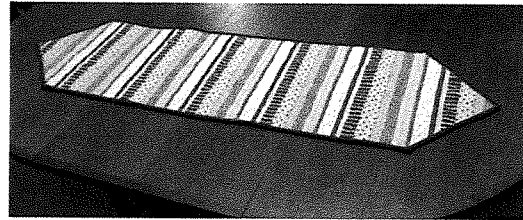
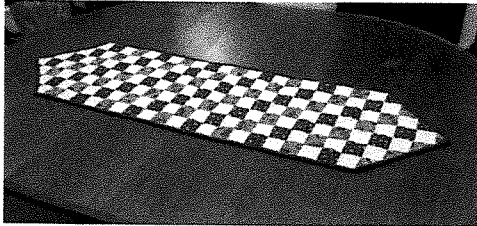

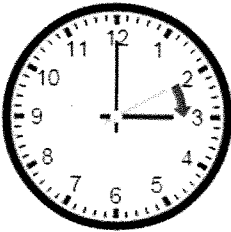
What projects have you been doing during lockdown?
